













WHY WYNN'S TRANSMISSION SERVICE?

- Automatic transmission replacement can cost more than \$2,500.




Dirty Transmission Fluid



Wynn's Transerve III Machine












UPGRADE OPPORTUNITIES








RECOMMENDING THE SERVICE

- When was the last time your vehicle had a Transmission Service? (Answer) We recommend
 a Transmission Service every three years to clean out debris & renew the fluid.
- Your car is overdue for a Transmission Service which we recommend is carried out every three years to maintain the condition & reliability of your transmission. I suggest we keep that up to date to avoid any future problems.
- We recommend your car has the Transmission serviced to remove internal debris & maintain the performance of your transmission. It's important we do it while it's here today to avoid any future expense.





DIAGNOSTIC QUESTION METHOD

- This will help to get more information from the customer than you would normally get.
- Use a list of open ended questions to get the customer to talk about their vehicle, this can jog their memory if they have had intermittent problems.
- "In order for us to provide a complete service for your vehicle today I just need to ask you a few questions about the history of your car over the last ?,000Kms."
- "How many of the following problems have you noticed: rough, sticking or slipping gear change?"






WORKSHOP TECHNICIAN INPUT

- Workshop technicians often identify issues that the regular driver of the vehicle has missed or simply got used to.
- Encourage technicians to tell you if a vehicle has a problem that a Wynn's Transmission Service could help.

- List the benefits from the owner-driver point of view.






